RE: PREMIUM TAX PAYMENT CHANGES

The Insurance Commission of The Bahamas ("the Commission") wishes to advise that **effective immediately** quarterly premium tax payments must be made to the Commission. The premium tax payment and quarterly premium reporting procedures are outlined below:

- 1. All registered insurers must pay premium taxes within four weeks of the end of each quarter of a financial year.
 - a. Cheques should be made payable to **The Insurance Commission of The Bahamas**.
 - b. As per the Business Licence Act the payment due is greater of 3% of gross premiums written or \$25.
 - c. The premium tax cover letter, which is available on the Commission's website (www.icb.gov.bs) should accompany all payments.
- 2. Licensees must submit the quarterly filings to the Commission within six weeks of the end of a calendar quarter.
