TO: ALL REGISTERED INSURANCE INTERMEDIARIES
RE: PUBLIC REGISTER INFORMATION

The Insurance Commission of The Bahamas (“the Commission”) wishes to advise that pursuant to section 19 of the Insurance Act Chapter 347, it is required to keep a Public Register for all Insurance Intermediaries, Companies and Associations.

This Public Register contains;

- the constitutive documents;
- the address of the principal office;
- the address of the principal representative (where applicable);
- a copy of the certificate of registration;
- copy of the most recent balance sheet and other financial statements determined by the Commission;
- the names and addresses of the officers;
- the companies and intermediaries with which business is conducted in The Bahamas, and
- such other information and documentation as may be directed by the Commission.

Any person may, upon payment of a prescribed fee, inspect any documents in this Public Register during normal business hours at the office of the Commission and may make a copy of any document in such register.
